



# HOW TO SIGN A PDF DOCUMENT FROM YOUR MOBILE

Until recently, signing a document to send it over the Internet required printing it beforehand, signing it with a pen, scanning it afterwards, converting it to a PDF document, and sending it by email.

Today all you need is a smartphone. We are going to show you how to sign a PDF document from your mobile, in a simple way with the Adobe Fill & Sign app, which is used to scan, fill and sign PDF documents.

## INSTALL THE APP AND OPEN IT

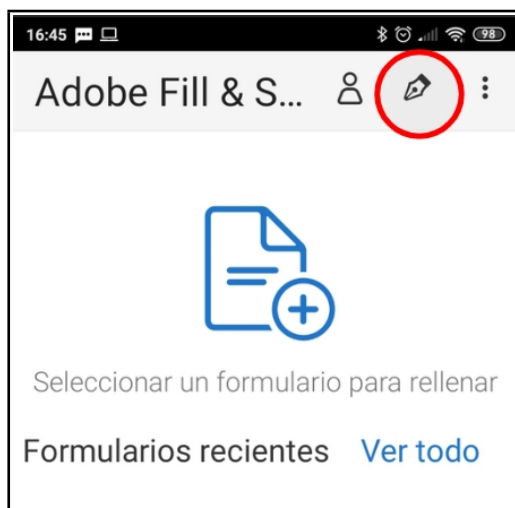
Download and set up **Adobe Fill & Sign** from these links for [iOS](#) or [Android](#). It is a free app.



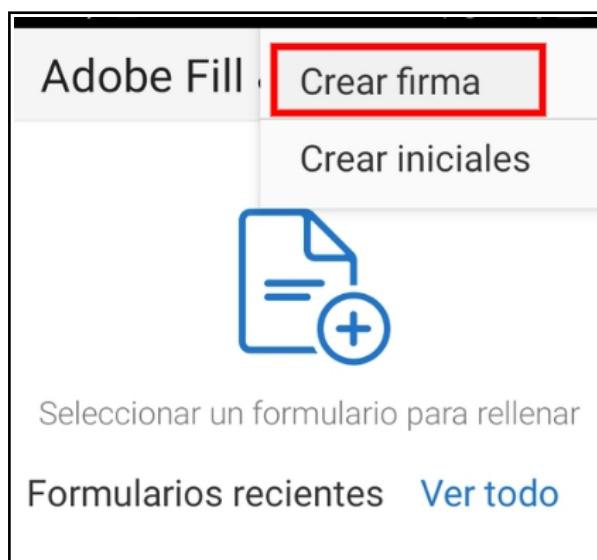
Open the app once it has been installed.

## CREATE THE SIGNATURE

Enter the application. At the top, tap the fountain pen icon.



Select **Crear firma** (Create signature).



You will have to write your signature with your finger on the screen.



If you don't like it, you can **Delete** and do it again. Once finished select **Hecho** (Done), the signature will be saved so you don't have to write it every time.

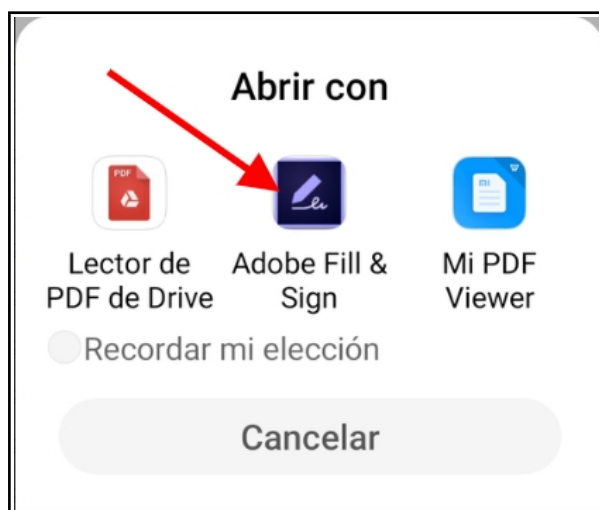
## OPEN THE DOCUMENT

Once you receive the email with the document to sign, touch the PDF document.





It will ask you for which program you want to open it with.



Select **Adobe fill & sign**.

You already have the document open in the application.

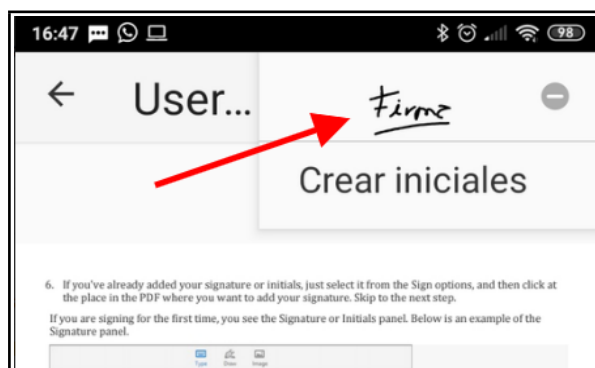


## SIGN THE DOCUMENT

Now select the fountain pen icon to place the signature.

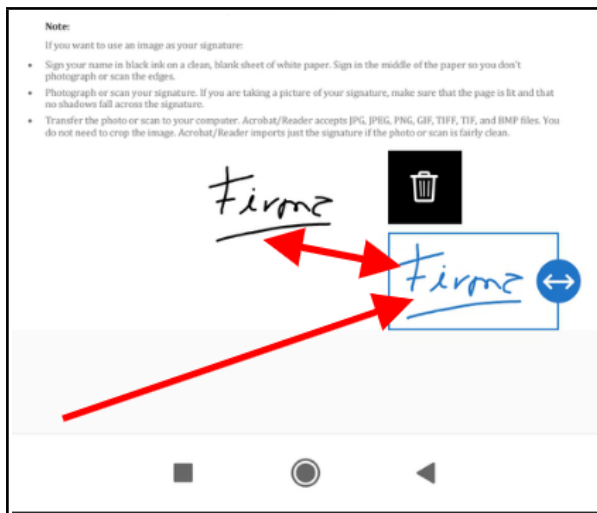


Select the previously created signature and it will be placed in the document.



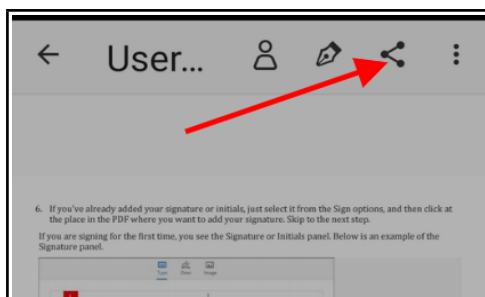


Press your finger on the signature and move it to the desired place.

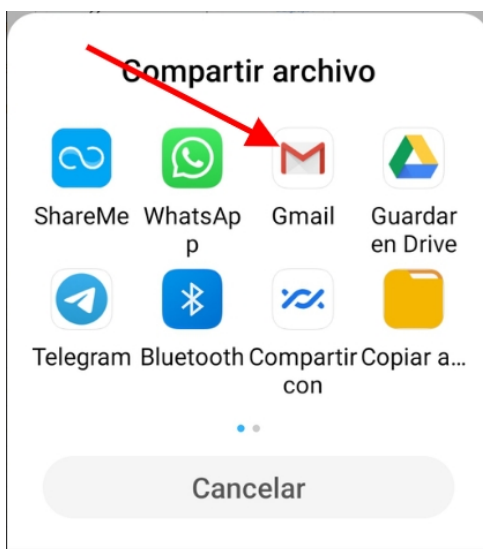


## SEND IT BY EMAIL

Once the signature is placed, touch the **Share** button to send the signed document by mail.



Select the mail program to send the document to the desired recipient.



The app creates the new document with the signature and the mail program sends it.

Done, we already have the PDF signed.
